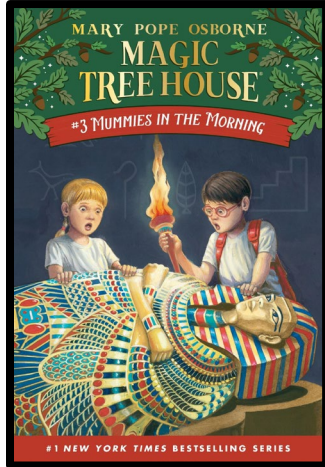


Supplementary Reading Materials

5th Grade

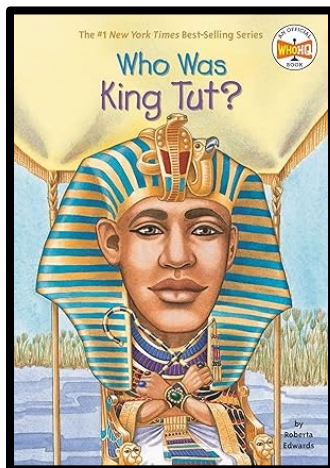
1. *Mummies in the Morning* by Mary Pope Osborne

Part of the Magic Tree House series, this adventure takes Jack and Annie back to ancient Egypt, where they explore pyramids and encounter a mysterious mummy.



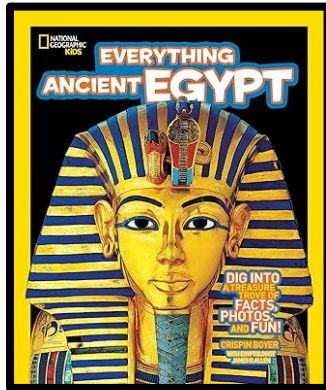
2. *Who Was King Tut?* by Roberta Edwards

A biography that introduces young readers to the life and legacy of the boy pharaoh, Tutankhamun, including the discovery of his tomb.



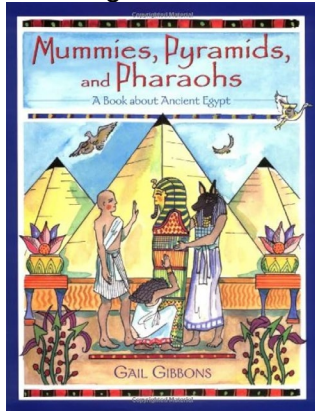
3. *Everything Ancient Egypt* by National Geographic Kids

Kids will discover all they want to know about the mysteries of ancient Egypt and learn new weird, wacky, and fascinating facts as well.



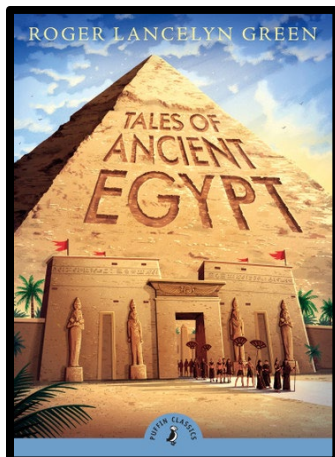
4. "Mummies, Pyramids, and Pharaohs: A Book About Ancient Egypt" by Gail Gibbons

5. *Tales of Ancient Egypt* by Roger Lancelyn Green

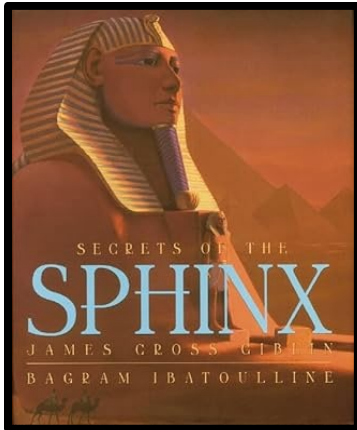
A collection of myths and legends from ancient Egypt, retold for young readers, covering gods, pharaohs, and heroes.



8th Grade

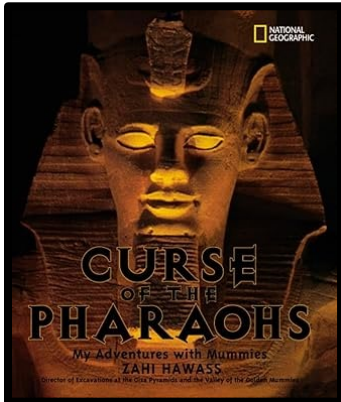
1. **Secrets of the Sphinx** by James Cross Griblin

Explores the history and mysteries surrounding the Great Sphinx, combining archaeology with historical detective work.



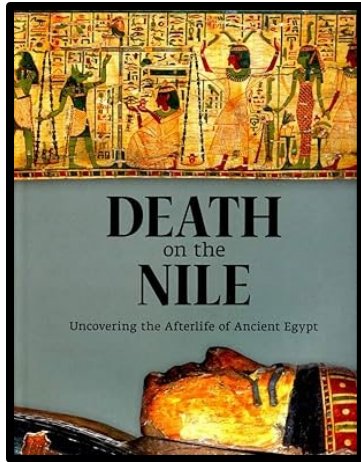
2. **The Curse of the Pharaohs: My Adventures with Mummies (National Geographic Investigates)** by Zahi Hawass

More detailed exploration of Egyptian civilization, archaeology, and recent discoveries.



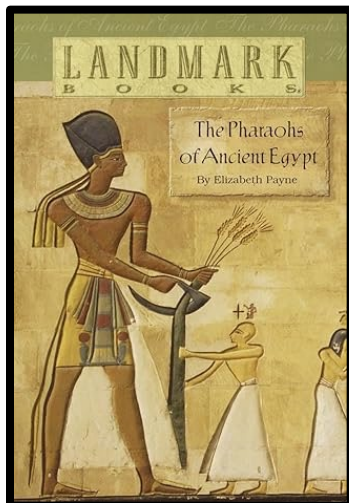
3. **Death on the Nile: Uncovering the Afterlife of Ancient Egypt** by Tamara Bower

Examines Egyptian beliefs about death and the afterlife with primary source materials.



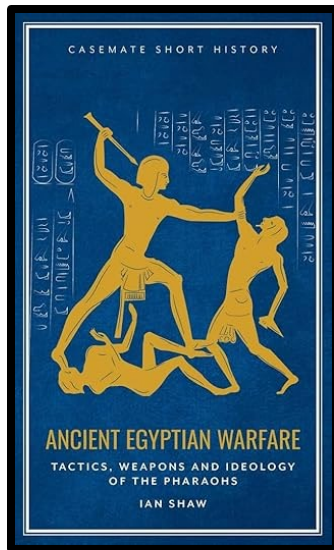
4. **The Pharaohs of Ancient Egypt** by Elizabeth Payne

5. **Ancient Egyptian Warfare** by Ian Shaw

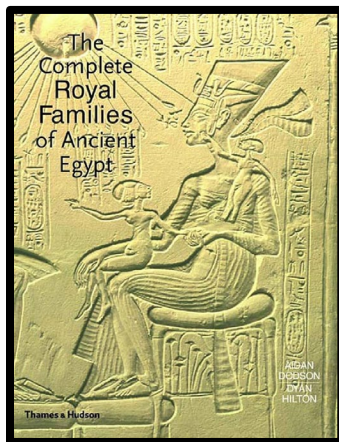
Explores military history, weapons, and battles that shaped the Egyptian empire.



10th Grade

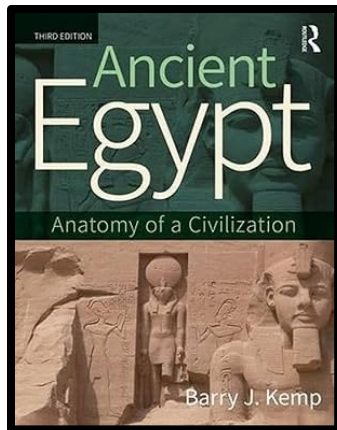
1. *The Complete Royal Families of Ancient Egypt* by Aidan Dodson

Detailed genealogies and biographies of Egyptian royal dynasties with complex historical analysis.



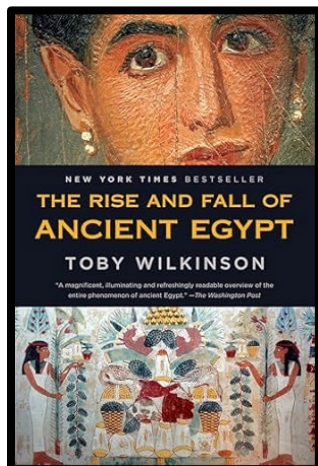
2. *Ancient Egypt: Anatomy of a Civilization* by Barry Kemp

Academic but accessible examination of Egyptian society, economy, and culture.



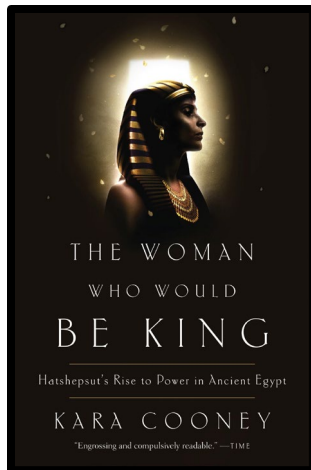
3. *The Rise and Fall of Ancient Egypt* by Toby Wilkinson
